

AVA Deb Strain

Quilt is 45"x 39" Tablerunner is 21"x 39" Quilt & Tablerunner Construction Quilter Basics

Read instructions before beginning a project. All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance. 22" measurement is approximate. WOF–approximately 40".

Checkerboard Block: (A) Sew $3-2\frac{1}{2}x22$ " Print and $2-2\frac{1}{2}x22$ " Background strips together. *See diagram.* Press away from the Background strips. Make 3 strip sets. Cut into $18-2\frac{1}{2}$ " segments. (B) Sew $2-2\frac{1}{2}x22$ " Print and $3-2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" Background strips together. Press away from the Background strips. *See diagram.* Make 3 strip sets. Cut into $18-2\frac{1}{2}$ " segments. (C) Combine segments to make 6 Checkerboards.



Quilt & Tablerunner Assembly

Join 4 Panels and 5 Checkboard Blocks into 3 rows of 3 blocks. *See diagram.* Press towards the Panels. Join the rows. Add the borders in the following

order: Inner borders: 2–1½"x 36½" Top & bottom 2–1½"x 32½" Sides Final borders: 2–4"x 38½" Top & bottom

 $2-4" \times 39\frac{1}{2}"$ Sides

Layer, quilt and bind.



Join 2 Panels and one Checkboard Block. *See diagram.* Add the borders in the following order:

Layer, quilt and bind.

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Quilt is 39"x 45" Tablerunner is 21"x 39'

Fabric Requirements for 2 Projects:

Checkerboard: 5 assorted prints 9"x 22" of EACH

Background:3/4 yardInner Border:3/8 yardFinal Border:one yardBinding:3/4 yardBacking:Quilt - 1½ yardsTablerunner - 7/8 yard

Cutting

Checkerboard: from EACH of 5 Prints cut $3-2\frac{1}{2}x22^{"}$ strips

Background: 8–2¹/₂" x WOF strips subcut 15–2¹/₂"x 22" strips

Inner Border: 2–1¹/₂"x 32¹/₂ strips (quilt) 2–1¹/₂"x 36¹/₂ strips (quilt)

1–1¹/₂"x WOF strip subcut 2–1¹/₂"x 14¹/₂ strips 2–1¹/₂"x 30¹/₂ strips

Final Border: 2–4"x 39¹/₂ strips (quilt) 2–4"x 38¹/₂ strips (quilt)

2-4"x 21½ strips 2-4"x 32½ strips

Binding: 8–2¹/2"x WOF strips
